

Notice of Unreasonable Request for Assistance Animal(s)

However, there are times when a request must be deemed unreasonable. For your convenience we have compiled a list of animals that we must consider unreasonable. They are as follows:

- **Farm Animals & Livestock:** Many city and county ordinances do not allow farm animals or livestock to be within their localities.
 - Pigs
 - Cows
 - Ponies
 - Chickens
 - Etc.

- **Exotic Animals:** Every state has different laws on what is considered "exotic", but they all have limitations that will vary.
 - Poisonous Snakes
 - Spiders
 - Lions
 - Tigers
 - Etc.

- **Aggressive Breed Animals:** There are many breeds of animals that are known and documented to be aggressive towards humans. For the safety of our other Residents and Community we cannot accommodate them.
 - Rottweiler
 - Pitt Bull
 - German Shepard
 - Wolf Dog Mixes
 - Etc.

- **Excessively Large Animals:** All of our Residents are entitled to "Quiet enjoyment" of their home. Large animals come with excessive noise as well, which can infringe on the rights of other Residents.
 - Great Danes
 - Mastiff
 - Horses
 - Etc.
